
Background DEAD box proteins, characterized by the conserved

motif Asp-Glu-Ala-Asp (DEAD), are putative RNA helicases. They are implicated in a number of






cellular processes involving alteration of RNA secondary structure such as translation initiation, nuclear and mitochondrial splicing, and ribosome and spliceosome assembly. Based on their distribution patterns, some members of this family are believed to be involved in embryogenesis, spermatogenesis, and cellular growth and division. This gene encodes a DEAD box protein, which exhibits RNA-dependent ATPase and ATP-dependent RNA-unwinding activities. This protein is recruited to the cytoplasmic fibrils of the nuclear pore complex, where it participates in the export of mRNA from the nucleus. Multiple alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jul 2008],



Western Blot analysis of various cells using DDX19B Polyclonal Antibody




Western blot analysis of lysates from HT-29 cells, using DDX19B Antibody. The lane on the right is blocked with the synthesized peptide.




